PROGRAMME OPENING ON 21ST OF SEPTEMBER 2017 IN SVETLOGORSK

The launching conference of the Programme was held in Svetlogorsk (Kaliningrad Oblast, Russian Federation) on the 21st of September 2017. More than 200 participants from Lithuania and Russia participated in the Programme opening event. During the conference participants had the opportunity to update the old and create new acquaintanceships, share their areas of interest with each other, provide questions to representatives of different Programme institutions as well as various experts.



The participants of the conference got acquainted with the results of the Lithuania, Poland and Russia ENPI Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2007-2013 and the possibilities provided by the Lithuania-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2014-2020. EUROPEAN COOPERATION RUN WAS BLESSED WITH PERFECT WEATHER



The European Cooperation Run has taken place in the Curonian Spit Nida resort. It was a part of the traditional Nida Half Marathon event which was organised 18th time already. Lithuania-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2014-2020 contributed to the organisation of this event.

The 0.5 km and 2 km distances were named the European Cooperation Run and were dedicated to Europe-wide celebration of the European Cooperation Day. More than 150 children participated in this European Cooperation Run. More than 100 children up to 12 years old ran 0.5 km and more than 45 runners up to 18 years old tackled the distance of 2 km dedicated to European cooperation. All the young runners received Programme gifts. Prize-winning runners received special prizes set up by the Programme, which were presented by the Mayor of the Neringa municipality Mr. Darius Jasaitis.
