The applications must have reached the Public establishment Joint Technical Secretariat (Konstitucijos Ave. 7 (24 floor), LT-09308, Vilnius) by the 10th of April 2018 14:00 (Vilnius time, GMT+2) via registered mail, private courier service or by hand-delivery.
