CBC PROGRAMMES WITH RUSSIA SHARED THEIR EXPERIENCE IN TARTU



All the EU and Russia cross-border cooperation (CBC) programmes were represented in Tartu (Estonia) on the 22nd-23rd of August 2018 in the “Northern cluster” network meeting with the aim to share experience and knowledge. More than 60 representatives of different programmes with the assistance of the experts of the TESIM project (technical assistance project to programmes) discussed such topics as public procurement, expenditure verification, partnership agreements, contracting, general data protection regulation, communication and more other various issues including the future perspective of the CBC programmes.

Such network meeting of the “Northern cluster” CBC programmes has been organised for the 2nd time. The joint work and discussions of the representatives of the Managing authorities, Joint technical secretariats and their branch offices ensured fruitful results such as better common understanding, new ideas and inspiration for introducing innovations.

The administrative compliance and technical eligibility check of the submitted applications of the 1st Call for Proposals was completed in June 2018. After this stage of the evaluation 45 project proposals are still competing for the Programme support.

The quality assessment stage shall be finalised soon. After the completion of the quality assessment stage, the Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) of the Programme shall decide on the grant awards. The JMC meeting is expected to take place in the 4th quarter of 2018.
