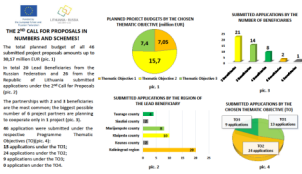

# Newsletter of the Lithuania–Russia Cross–Border Cooperation Programme 2014-2020

## 46 APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED DURING THE 2<sup>ND</sup> CALL FOR PROPOSALS!



By the deadline of the 17<sup>th</sup> of April, 2019, the JTS received 46 applications. The total planned budget of all 46 submitted project proposals amounts up to 30,2 million EUR.

In contrast to the 1<sup>st</sup> call (where Priority 1.1 was the most popular), this time Programme Priority 2.1 attracted the most attention of applicants – 52 % (24 out of 46) of applications have been submitted precisely under this priority. 28 % of applications have been applied under Priority 1.1 (13 out of 46) and 20 % of applications - under Priority 3.1 (9 out of 46).

The biggest number of the received applications (21 out of 46) involves 2 beneficiaries in a project. 57 % (26 out of 46) of applications have been submitted by the Lead Beneficiaries from Lithuania and 43 % (20 out of 46) – from Kaliningrad region.

## GRANT CONTRACT AND PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT IN RUSSIAN LANGUAGE

First grant contracts will be signed soon, which means that the implementation phase for projects is just around the corner!

## PROJECTS OF THE 2<sup>ND</sup> CALL FOR PROPOSALS ARE PROCEEDING FOR THE QUALITY ASSESSMENT

The administrative compliance and technical eligibility check of the submitted applications of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Proposals is now completed.

The next and final phase is the quality assessment. After the completion of the quality assessment stage, the Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) of the Programme shall decide on the grant awards. The JMC meeting is expected to take place in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2019.
