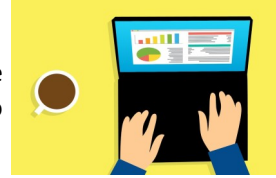

### 48 applications submitted during the 3rd call!

By the deadline of the 30<sup>th</sup> of April, 2020, 48 applications were submitted to the JTS. The total planned budget of all 48 submitted project proposals amounts up to 25,6 million EUR.



Comparing to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Proposal's results the same Thematic Objectives were the most demanded. 52 % (25 out of 48) of applications have been submitted under Priority 2.1. "Promotion of social inclusion and cooperation in CBC region through improved health, social and education services and community led initiatives". 31 % of applications have been applied under Priority 1.1 "Restoration and adaptation of historical and natural heritage, promotion of culture, cultural networking and tourism development" (15 out of 48) and 17 % of applications - under Priority 3.1 "Promotion of cooperation between public authority institutions and strengthening local communities" (8 out of 48).

The biggest number of the received applications (22 out of 48) involves 2 beneficiaries in a project. 71% (34 out of 48) of applications have been submitted by the Lead beneficiaries from Lithuania and 29% (14 out of 48) - from Kaliningrad region.

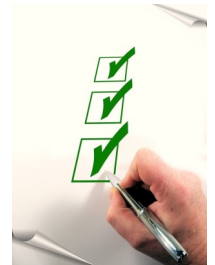
### Projects of the 3rd Call are in the process of the first assessment stage

The administrative compliance and technical eligibility check of the submitted applications of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Call for Proposals is now being carried out. The first letters regarding clarifications or missing documents for the Applicants, who provided the documents in paper version or sent the signed version electronically via e-mail, have been sent out. However, we are still waiting for the last original documents from applicants and project partners who submitted the applications only as the scanned versions.

### The majority of Grant Contracts of the 2nd Call have been signed

The majority of the grant contracts (9 out of 12) for the projects of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Proposals are already signed. It means that almost all the projects have already started their implementation Good luck to all projects of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Call
