THREE JOINT PROGRAMMING COMMITTEE MEETINGS TOOK PLACE ONLINE

The 4th, 5th and 6th Joint Programming Committee meetings were taking place online via Zoom platform on the 27th of April, 21st of May and 21st of June, 2021. During the meetings, Lithuanian and Russian national delegations discussed issues related to approval of Programme territorial analysis and identified needs and potentials of Lithuania-Russia cross-border cooperation programme 2021-2027 and the Programme strategy of the 2021-2027 Lithuania-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Programme with proposed priorities and specific objectives.

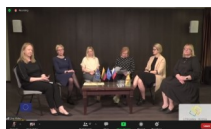
